RSVP program reaches more than one hundred Pender students

It is the beginning of the Christmas season and RSVP has so much to be thankful for this year. We now have volunteers at Burgaw, Cape Fear, West Pender and Topsail Middle Schools. A total of 39 volunteers are making an impact on reading scores with more than 100 students in our community.

This November, we held a training class for our tutoring volunteers to prepare them to connect with students in our program. Hopefully in February, we can add Penderlea School. That will complete all the middle schools in Pender County.

In our companion/respite care program, we have 21 RSVP volunteers that are assisting 28 clients who are not able to leave home and run errands. These volunteers help with everyday activities, provide companion care and help them connect to resources that help them continue living independently at home.

Volunteers provide respite care to caregivers so they can attend to their own needs and have time to themselves. Thank you to Michael Harris, Hospice coordinator, for the excellent training he provided volunteers on fall prevention.

Volunteers were warned to be careful not to prevent a client's fall, and be brought down in a fall with them. Excellent facts and stories emphasized the importance of checking surroundings to prevent an accident or fall.

Our six mentally-challenged young adults are mentored by six volunteers working beside them at the library, Pender Christian Services and Pender Adult Services. We have seen positive improvement with these students as they go to work in the community.

The entire class of 20 students has participated in decorating cans for the Hampstead Garden Club to provide table flower arrangements for nursing homes.

The class made Christmas decorations for Meals on Wheels and created cards for shut-ins. A training class will be held in January to assist these volunteers in mentoring and encouraging these young people to continue volunteering and giving back to their community.

In honor of our veterans RSVP delivered four large tubs of food to 4-C's Food Pantry and Pender Christian Services Food Bank. This food was much needed as the Thanksgiving and Christmas holidays are here. With our RSVP program now in the second year of our grant, it is important for us to recruit more volunteers so we can service more clients in our county.

It is my hope that during this Christmas season more people will be filled with the holiday spirit and the commitment to pay it forward by volunteering with RSVP. Two to four hours a week can make such a difference in the life of another.
